OVERVIEW



Houston Christian High School engages students in an empowering, dynamic education from a Christian worldview, developing young adults into effective and impactful leaders.

In addition, 70 percent of its faculty are awarded advanced degrees. Houston Christian provides rigorous, collegiate-style academic programs where students are challenged to discover their potential and become difference-makers in their communities.

A Houston Christian education goes beyond a transference of knowledge. It develops a rich culture of learning and inquiry that has produced National Merit Scholars, Fulbright Scholars, perfect SAT and ACT scores, and graduates who attend the most esteemed universities in the country. A Christ-filled community and stellar academics are not mutually exclusive at Houston Christian but integrated fully and without compromise.

A Houston Christian education has relevance because it helps students build a moral compass – good or bad, moral standards are learned by students from the people who surround them. Many schools lack the freedom to define these values or they take a neutral stance. We believe there is no such thing. All educators take a position in how they live and work before young people. Even the absence of faith is a faith-based decision.

At Houston Christian, we build students' knowledge and understanding of God's Word through all academic disciplines and equip them as leaders to serve where their gifts and abilities take them. Houston Christian intentionally fosters our students' talents and provides them with an opportunity to be more.



In addition, the School's graduating classes regularly receive more than \$7 million in collegiate scholarships. Houston Christian's alumni frequent corporate boardrooms, Broadway stages, courtrooms, pulpits, and classrooms worldwide. HCHS takes pride in the success of its students and looks forward to celebrating future graduates as they positively contribute to global communities through their careers and service.

HISTORY

Houston Christian High school opened its doors in the summer of 1998 to 207 students after a group of evangelical pastors decided to launch a school with the vision of providing rigorous, Christ-centered education for Houston families. Two years later, a forty-five-acre tract of land on the West Sam Houston Parkway was gifted to the School, and construction on our beautiful, collegiate-style campus began. Since then, Houston Christian has grown in student population, campus facilities, and academic and extracurricular programming, fulfilling its mission of providing dynamic, empowering education to the Greater Houston Area.



THE GEORGE AND BARBARA BUSH CENTER FOR SCHOLARS AND LEADERS







Replicating the university honors college experience, the Distinguished Scholar Program is the George and Barbara Bush Center for Scholars and Leaders signature program. Admittance is for students exhibiting exceptional academic potential. Scholars engage critical texts from Western and non-Western cultures, learn and use interdisciplinary research methods and materials.

Under faculty mentorship, students develop independent research in a discipline of their choosing, resulting in original scholarship for submission to academic conferences and journals.

The George and Barbara Bush Center for Scholars and Leaders hosts a Distinguished Leader Speaker Series each year. On February 1, 2022, Jean Becker and Jim McGrath shared behind-the-scenes stories about President George Bush, a man driven by service, and his wife, Barbara Bush. Houston Chrisitan students discovered much about the 41st President George H.W. Bush, who Jean worked side-by-side with for 25 years as his Chief of Staff. Jim, his longtime spokesperson, and friend, shared some of Bush's most exciting and unexpected moments. Most importantly, Jean and Jim's stories affirmed many values the Houston Christian community share with these two outstanding Americans. At the end of the program, Jean Becker and Jim McGrath received the Distinguished Service Medal for Public Service.



ACADEMICS



The Houston Christian curriculum supports a standard of excellence, leading students to maximize their academic, spiritual, and leadership potential. Sixteen AP courses are offered across the disciplines. Students receive lessons on leadership in every course. An optional diploma endorsement is provided in Leadership Studies, and students are encouraged to complete community service each year. Houston Christian requires a robust code of conduct and holds students accountable for behavior on and off campus.

PROGRAM FOR COLLEGE READINESS

The Program for College Readiness is a specialized program exclusive to Houston Christian High School designed to vigorously support students with mild to moderate diagnosed learning differences. Our tiered approach to the program allows students the specific support they need as they mature at Houston Christian. In addition, the Program for College Readiness also aims to empower students to take charge of their learning and use self-advocacy and other acquired academic skills to propel them during high school, college, and beyond.

LIVINGSTON LEARNING COMMONS

The library, also known as The Livingston Learning Commons in honor of the founding Head of School, Dr. Stephen M. Livingston, is the busiest place on campus. Designed to stimulate collaboration and inquiry, Houston Christian's learning commons partners traditional resources with the latest digital technology. As a result, the learning commons continually refreshes its collection with new books and resources, furnished with print volumes, nearly five million eBooks, research journals, encyclopedias, periodicals, and online videos.

COLLEGE COUNSELING

Houston Christian High School offers a comprehensive counseling program that strives to challenge and encourage students to grow into young men and women with a solid Christian faith, high academic achievement, and moral responsibility. College counseling at Houston Christian is active, intentional, and individualized, beginning in ninth grade and continuing through the end of senior year. The department provides students and parents with the tools to navigate the increasingly competitive and complicated college application process by offering individual and group meetings, visits with college representatives, an annual college tour, workshops for parents and students, and individual advising on all aspects of the college search and the application process.





ARTS & ATHLETICS





ARTS

Fine Arts at Houston Christian encompasses a broad array of activities that include both performance art, such as theatre, orchestra and choir, and visual art, such as pottery and photography. Students learn real-world application for art and performance through hosting regular guest speakers and collaborating on projects with local art leaders. They also showcase their talents through seasonal concerts and performances, including an outdoor fall concert, holiday concert and art show, and spring musical.

ATHLETICS

The Athletic Department of Houston Christian High School strives to strengthen students' physical, mental, and spiritual well-being through a healthy combination of competition and community. The athletic department's goal is for every student who wishes to play high school athletics to receive a positive, high-quality experience. Houston Christian provides a place where students of any skill level can connect with their peers through Dynamic Sports Training and coaches.

Houston Christian is a member of the Southwest Preparatory Conference, allowing students to play up to three sports per year during the fall, winter, and spring seasons. Houston Christian offers 13 sports and a strength and development coach who will provide personalized programs in our Harrell Family Strength and Conditioning Center.

Governance and Finance

The Board of Trustees of Houston Christian High School is set up on a unique model that preserves the mission and heritage of the school and ensures that current and future students receive an excellent education based on a Christian worldview and that its graduates will become impactful leaders in their neighborhoods and the world. The school was founded by a group of four evangelical pastors (Baptist, Methodist, Presbyterian, and Lutheran) who dreamed of providing rigorous, Christ-centered education for young adults in the Greater Houston Area. The board maintains appointments for four permanent "pastor trustees" to preserve the founding vision. The board consists of four pastor members and 17 trustees, with current parents limited to no more than 60% of the total. The board is charged with oversight and governance of the school (working through its by-laws, board policies, and a committee structure.) At the same time, day-to-day operations and management are the responsibility of the Head of School and his/her administrative team. The financial position of Houston Christian High School is excellent. The campus consists of a \$55-million campus of purpose-built educational facilities on a total of 45 acres, with prospects for future growth as needed.




LIVING IN HOUSTON




Why Houston?


