Founded in 1987, The da Vinci School is a non-denominational, non-profit organization teaching children ages 18 months though kindergarten/primer. It has a well-rounded, learning-oriented program with a special emphasis on science. They believe science is the platform from which young children come to understand and respect all life. Through hands-on teaching, children can dive deep into the world of knowledge. Its teachers are carefully screened and selected for their abilities to nurture as well as stimulate and educate. Diversity in the school population is encouraged, and they strive to expose the children to a wide range of cultural traditions.

At The da Vinci School they recognize and appreciate the needs and wants of parents, cultivate a powerful partnership with the parent community and strive to place the best interests of the child first and foremost in its decision-making process. They want the children to end their day before they are ready for it to end. This way, they will always be excited and happy to come back!

The Program



The da Vinci School takes a thematic approach to learning, with science as its primary emphasis (social studies is a secondary focus). Young children have a tremendous curiosity about the world around them. They want to know – What is that? How does it work? Why is it that way? and Let ME try it! For this reason, the classrooms emphasize hands-on learning.

Science is also a rich springboard for exploring the other developmental disciplines – art, literature, language and reading skills, cognitive processes, practical life skills, fine and gross motor development, math concepts, music, and social development. These skills can be enjoyably acquired in the context of topics young children find interesting and appealing. It also creates a fun, interesting, and creative teaching approach for its staff!

While the curriculum creates the structure for the program, the relationships that young children develop with their teachers is what makes school such a special place to come each day. Classes are small so the teachers get to know and interact with each student. The result is a safe and loving environment that captures the young child's interests and opens the door to a life of learning.







The Campus



The da Vinci School moved into its present location in 2010. More than five years were devoted to research and construction to create an exceptional learning environment for young children.


The building has gold LEED certification from the U. S. Green Building Council, among the first of its kind to be dedicated solely to early childhood education. The founders wanted a facility that respects the environment by operating in an ecologically responsible manner, protects students by avoiding possible pollutants in building materials or cleaning products, and models sound construction and operating practices for families and for the community.

In 2018, the school purchased the adjacent church property, which includes a substantial parking area and 3 buildings on 3.5 acres.
